The purpose of this application is to help the University of Valley Forge determine your eligibility for a tuition scholarship. Students must enroll in a resident degree program. Returning students must also maintain a cumulative 2.0 GPA.

Students who are ministers, missionaries, minister/missionary dependents, and/or a spouse in the Assemblies of God (licensed or ordained for a minimum of 2 years) will receive a scholarship for the academic year. Those in "mainstream denominations" will receive half of the Assemblies of God amounts for the academic year upon application and approval.
