## Step 1. Scroll down to Explore VA benefits and healthcare area, and Click Education and Training



Step 2. Scroll down to Get GI Bill® and other education benefits area, and click How to apply



Step 3. Scroll down to How do I apply? area and click Find your education benefits form.



Step 4. Answer the questions that are generated, then click *Apply now*.
