MUSIC TUITION

The University of Valley Forge is proud of young people and their involvement in church ministries, community service, and school programs. Music scholarships are available for freshman music majors and non-music majors alike. Non-music majors who receive this tuition scholarship from the Music Department will be required to participate in one of the choirs or instrumental ensembles for the duration of the award. The actual amount for the scholarship is based on an audition and the awards range from \$200 - \$3,000.

Criteria for Auditions:

- Perform two contrasting pieces (only one piece required for Breakaway auditions).
- One piece may be classical and the other may be contemporary.

Or

 Both pieces may be classical (one should be allegro, the other should be slower and more reflective).

Or

- Both pieces may be contemporary (one should be upbeat and the other should be slower).
- Percussionists should be prepared with two solo pieces (from contest level literature and also be able to demonstrate knowledge of rudiments. If audition is on a drum set or trap, the student will be asked to play in all time signatures.
- Guitarists (acoustic and electric) should include both melodic and harmonic elements as part of the audition pieces.
- Bassists should demonstrate appropriate bass techniques within the two prepared pieces.
- To schedule an appointment for an audition, contact the Admissions Office at UVF or the Music Department at 610.917.3954.
- Dress appropriately.
- Music must be memorized.
- Pre-recorded accompaniments may be used for the audition.
 Additionally, a live accompanist is welcomed, or performance may be a cappella.
- Make eye contact with the evaluators when singing.
