Your 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. To verify that you provided correct information the Office of Financial Services at UVF will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Office of Financial Services at UVF. UVF may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact your financial aid administrator as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

The transcript displays online upon successful completion of the IRS's two-step authentication.
