# What will I be selecting during Housing Selection Night?

• You will be selecting your <u>Housing</u> and your <u>Meal Plan</u> for the 2025-2026 Academic Year

# What do I need to do to get my Lottery Number?

- Your FASFA needs to be filled out and sent to UVF's Financial Services
- You need to be pre-Registered for classes for the Fall Semester

# What does my Lottery Number mean?

- Your lottery number can be chosen based on your current completed credits:
  - Freshmen: 0-29.5 Credits
  - Sophomores: 30-59.5 Credits
  - o Juniors: 60-89.5 Credits
  - Seniors: 90+ Credits
- Depending on your credits, you will choose a number from your class cup which will mark your place on when we will call you

# Who do I ask questions about my FASFA and how to fill it out?

#### How do I pre-Register for classes?

- Registration for classes opens for Juniors and Seniors on March 10<sup>th</sup>

#### How do I get my Lottery Number?

- From March 17<sup>th</sup> to March 21<sup>st</sup>, you can select your number from the Student Life Office
- You can select your lottery number <u>only</u> if you have completed both your FASFA and are preregistered for classes
