

Housing Selection Night FAQs

When is Housing Selection Night?

- The Housing Lottery will be held on Wednesday, April 9th over Microsoft Teams from 9:00 PM to 11:00 PM

What will I be selecting during Housing Selection Night?

- You will be selecting your Housing and your Meal Plan for the 2025-2026 Academic Year

What do I need to do to get my Lottery Number?

- Your FASFA needs to be filled out and sent to UVF's Financial Services
- You need to be pre-Registered for classes for the Fall Semester

What does my Lottery Number mean?

- Your lottery number can be chosen based on your current completed credits:
 - Freshmen: 0-29.5 Credits
 - Sophomores: 30-59.5 Credits
 - Juniors: 60-89.5 Credits
 - Seniors: 90+ Credits
- Depending on your credits, you will choose a number from your class cup which will mark your place on when we will call you

How do I pre-Register for classes?

- Registration for classes opens for Juniors and Seniors on March 10th
- Registration for classes opens for First-year Students and Sophomores on March 17th

How do I get my Lottery Number?

- From March 17th to March 21st, you can select your number from the Student Life Office
- You can select your lottery number only if you have completed both your FASFA and are pre-registered for classes
