NEW STUDENTS ARRIVE & CHECK IN

9 AM- 1 PM START AT THE TENT BY THE HARRUP ADMINISTRATION BUILDING

The big day is finally here! Arriving during this time will allow you to check in and then move into your room (resident students) before the evening's events. Check-in begins at the tent by the Harrup Administration Building. Please schedule your arrival time based on the first letter of your last name:

A - I = 9AM - 10AM

J - R = 10AM - 11AM

S - Z = 11AM - 12PM

When you check in, you will receive a lanyard with a schedule of events. The lanyard will serve as your student ID until you receive your ID card. Be prepared to take your student ID photo when you check in!

Please note that important paperwork (such as your Health Form) and documentation (such as your Financial Plan) must be complete before you can move into your room. Check your enrollment portal or contact your Admissions Counselor to get all paperwork done before you arrive.
