



Your Month-by-Month Enrollment Timeline

Get ready for your first semester at UVF!
Here's a quick breakdown of what needs to happen—and when.

September - Start the Journey

Submit your application to UVF

- Send Official Transcripts to admissions@valleyforge.edu
- Fall 2026 applications are open until August 2026

October - Begin Early Action

Complete the FAFSA

- This allows you to receive your financial aid package
- Add UVF to the form using **school code 003306**

Begin to search and apply for outside scholarships

November - Experience Campus

Visit our campus

- Attend a Breakaway, Open House, or Personalized Visit during your senior year of high school and receive a Visit Scholarship
- Registration for UVF visit opportunities is available on valleyforge.edu/visit

December - Secure Your Spot

Deposit by December 15 for an *Early Decision Scholarship*

Continue to search and apply for outside scholarships

January & February - Narrow Your Search

Review your Financial Aid Letter with your Admissions Counselor

Attend Winter Preview Day (for accepted students) in February

March & April - Get Ready

Apply for State Grants

- *PA State Grant applications are due by **May 1**—apply through PHEAA portal*
- *For states other than PA, check your state's website for deadlines*

May - Make it Official

Complete Course Registration

Our Registrar's Office will schedule your classes once you complete one of the following:

- *Submit **ACT/SAT** scores*
- ***OR** take **UVF Placement Exams***
- ***OR** submit final **Official College Transcripts** (Dual Enrollment or Transfer students)*

Submit your Housing Form

- *This step is required before you can receive your semester bill*

After graduation, request Official High School Transcripts be sent to:
admissions@valleyforge.edu

June - Get Set

Receive your Semester Bill

- *Physical & online copies available once you've been scheduled for classes and housed*

Attend an Admitted Student Day

- *Choose from: **June 26** (in-person), **July 17** (in-person), **July 24** (virtual)*

Student-Athletes: Submit your NCAA ID and complete the Athletic Training System Portal - Due June 1

July - Wrap Up the Details

Complete your Enrollment Checklist

Make sure these forms (found in your Enrollment Portal) are completed:

- *Health Form*
- *Vehicle Registration*
- *Immunization Records*
- *Student Account Responsibility & Title IV Authorization Form*
- *Loan accept/denial form*
- *Loan Entrance Counseling (if accepting federal loans)*
- *Master Promissory Note (if accepting federal loans)*

Choose your Payment Plan

- *If you choose a **monthly payment plan**, your first payment is due **July 28***
- *If you choose **upfront payment**, finalize Financial Plan by **Aug 1***

Submit AP Scores (if applicable)

August - It's Go Time!

Finalize your Financial Plan - Due Aug 1

- *This includes all information regarding loans, scholarships & grants, payment plans, and upfront payment*

Submit all UVF Scholarship Forms - Due Aug 1

Student-Athletes: submit your Physical Form and Sickle Cell Results by Aug 1

Student-Athletes: Ensure NCAA Compliance Forms are complete - Due Aug 7

Get ready to arrive!

- *Fall Student-Athletes check-in: **Aug 20***
(Fall sports: men's and women's soccer, women's volleyball, men's and women's cross country)
- *New Student check-in: **Aug 27***
- *Classes begin: **Aug 31***
- *Add/drop deadline: **Sept 8***
